



THINGS TO EXPECT AFTER LASIK SURGERY

THE DISCOMFORT YOU MAY FEEL USUALLY LASTS BETWEEN 1 AND 2 DAYS. YOU MAY EXPERIENCE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING NORMAL OCCURANCES:

- Moderate to significant discomfort
- Light sensitivity
- A scratchy, grittiness, or burning sensation
- More tearing than usual
- Vision may appear particularly blurry for several days
- You may notice red spots in the whites of your eyes
- For the first few weeks, you may notice fluctuations in your vision, particularly when reading and driving
- Your eyes may feel dry for up to 3-6 months following your treatment, use artificial tears to alleviate dry eyes.
- Glare/Halos/Starbursts around lights at night, gradually subsiding over several months.
- If you have discomfort, you may take Advil, Nuprin, Tylenol, or Aspirin for relief.
